# WHAT PROGRAMS DO WE OFFER?

→ ANZSOG offers a range of inbound and outbound programs for international delegations offered on an annual basis. Currently these include:

ANZSOG also offers customised international education programs in response to emerging needs of governments / jurisdictions



## The China Advanced Leadership Program (CALP)

An annual **three-week program** for Chinese officials, delivered in Australia and Aotearoa New Zealand. The aim of the program is to develop productive relationships between high level public officials of Australia, Aotearoa New Zealand and China. The program has been operational since 2011 and is delivered across multiple Australian and Aotearoa New Zealand cities.

## The India Advanced Leadership Program (IALP)

A **one-week program** delivered in Melbourne, Sydney and Wellington to Indian public officials with the aim to develop a positive and productive relationship between high level public officials of Australia, Aotearoa New Zealand and India. Inaugerated in 2013, there are now more than 140 ANZSOG IALP alumni in senior positions within India's public services – from the central government to a large number of the states.



## The China Reciprocal Program (CRP)

A **two-week intensive in-country program**. visiting multiple cities across China, this program provides an opportunity for Australia and Aotearoa New Zealand senior public officials to gain a deeper understanding of China. The program introduces participants to senior Chinese officials and explores information, ideas, values and beliefs with a focus on the Chinese system of government.
